    - 16% – Tier 2
    - 13% – Tier 3
  - Looked at the BOY – READ Act Data by grade level K–3

#### 5. Enrollment and Projections

- Currently at 728 including 20 in ECE
- Looked at class sizes and demographics
- Then looked at future projections
  - 715 – just came out today
  - 2nd, 4th will have 5 classes per grade level
  - Looking at 5th grade – it is looking large
    - It is possible that we might need to add another class or just keep the classes bigger with the strong teachers in 5th
      - Keeping an eye on this (128–130)
    - Thinking about budget
  - Mosaic – many of our families came in December/January and will lose their stipend, we have already seen families leave
    - We are also wondering if new families with kids will move in
    - Mosaic is going to build 56 additional affordable housing in the next few years (12–36 months out)
  - Apartments on Colfax – not sure what impact that might have
